CRRF AND ITS EDUCATIONAL MANDATE

The Canadian Race Relations Foundations (CRRF) regularly receives requests for anti-racism training and workshops. These requests have amplified following the tragic incident captured on video for others to see on May 25, 2020.

By 2023, CRRF's Strategic Plan seeks to have strengthened the organization and re-establish its position with Canadian race relations stakeholders as a convenor and enabler. Events unfolding this year have both accelerated the urgency of and required re-prioritization of some of our activities in response to stakeholder requests and needs.

CRRF is a valued education resource with a record of developing educational and training resources focused on both youth and adults. As an enabler, we should respond to broad public demand for education focused on anti-racism, leveraging our education experience to facilitate a relevant, updated and timely workshop on anti-racism. We propose developing a half-day workshop with an option to add module(s) tailored to specific interest(s). This workshop is intended to address understanding systemic racism, emotional impact, social relationships, diversity training and bias.

OUR ANTI-RACISM WORKSHOP

CRRF Anti-Racism Workshop seeks to build on the achievements of the Canada Beyond 150 initiative and an updated bibliographic search capacity. Our goal is to develop capacity for equity, offering a safe space for discussion and conversation about equity, race, and human rights, while simultaneously helping participants navigate differences, diversity, power relationships and conflict. The curriculum is designed for an experiential learning environment. Expert and screened facilitators will deliver a standard national framework.

The workshop's target audience is all Canadians, whether as an individual or organizational request. Participants materials include pre-workshop reading, in-workshop materials and post-workshop resources. Each workshop will be conducted by two approved facilitators with subject matter expertise.

Workshop Format and Delivery

The workshop is designed for a one half-day (4 hours) duration. This may be extended to accommodate customized requests.

1. Small group format (up to 15 individuals)
2. Virtual delivery
3. Professionally facilitated
4. Discussion with leaders in the anti-racism field
5. Toolkit and resources

Participant Cost

CRRF estimates the per participant cost to be \$75.
