CRRF COMMUNITY MOBILIZATION FUND

By 2023, CRRF's Strategic Plan seeks to have strengthened the organization and re-establish its position with Canadian race relations stakeholders as a convener and enabler. Events unfolding this year have both accelerated the urgency of and required re-prioritization of some of our activities in response to stakeholder requests and needs.

The CRRF has received more than \$200,000 in donations from individuals and organizations directed for general use. We are committed to developing and aligning initiatives that include a focus on anti-Black, anti-Asian and anti-Indigenous racism efforts. The valuable contribution supports continuing our mandate: development, sharing and application of knowledge and expertise contributing to the elimination of racism and all forms of racial discrimination in Canadian society.

We would like to propose the ***CRRF Community Mobilization Fund***, an important means by which CRRF implements its strategic plan. The CRRF will be providing grants from *\$5,000 - \$20,000* for anti-racism projects across the country. All application grantees must indicate in their application form if they are able to continue a project if they were to receive only partial funding. The CRRF will be asking organizations to indicate their successes in the past three years as well as how they can continue to build on those successes with the funding received from the CRRF.
